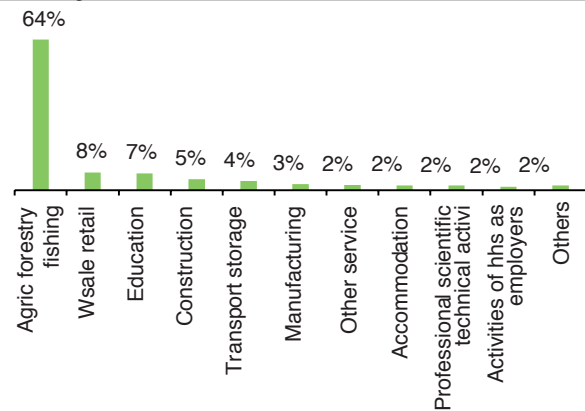
Sector Contribution to Total County GCP (%)



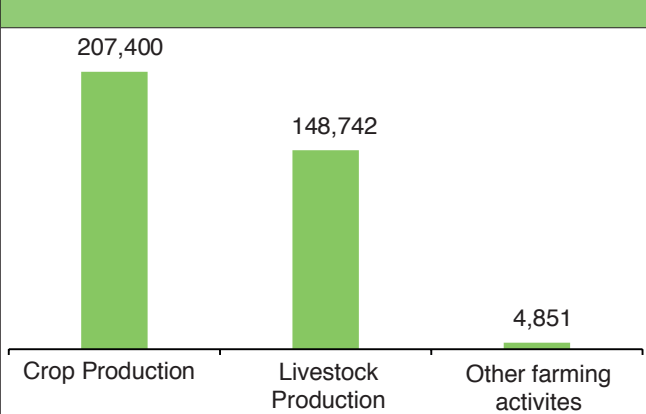
Average County Sector Contribution to overall sector Gross value Added (GVA) (%)



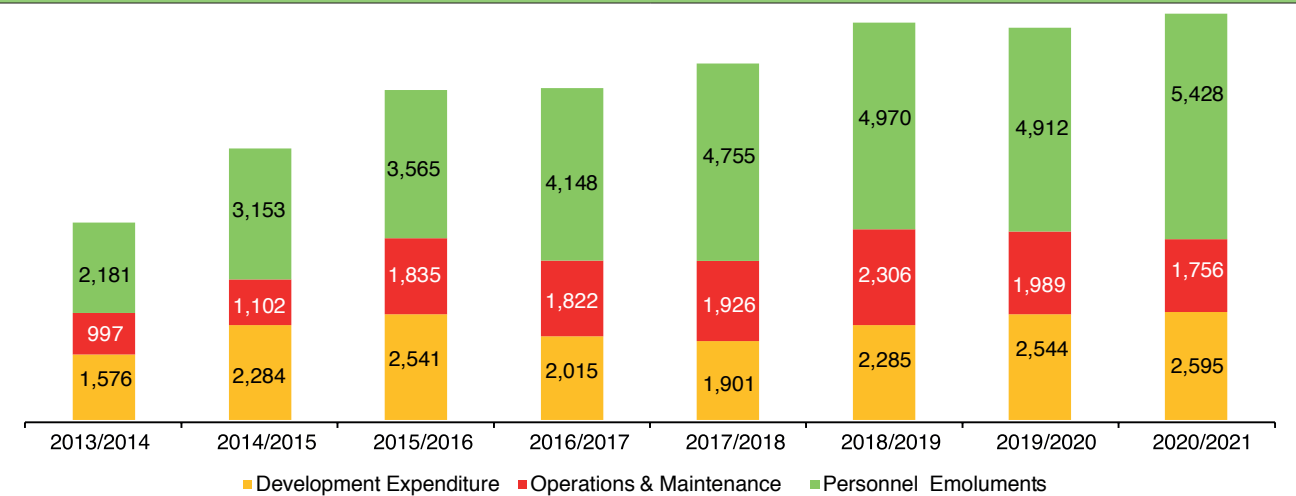
Percent of Population Engaged in Economic Activities by Sector as at 2015/16



Households engaged in farming activities

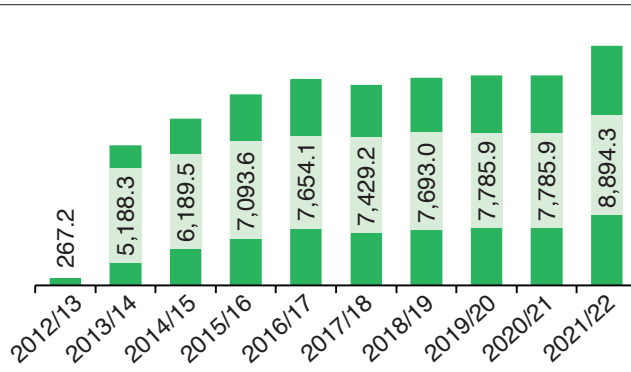

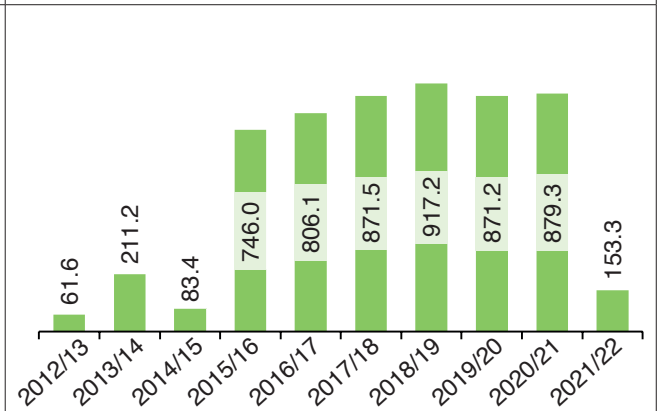

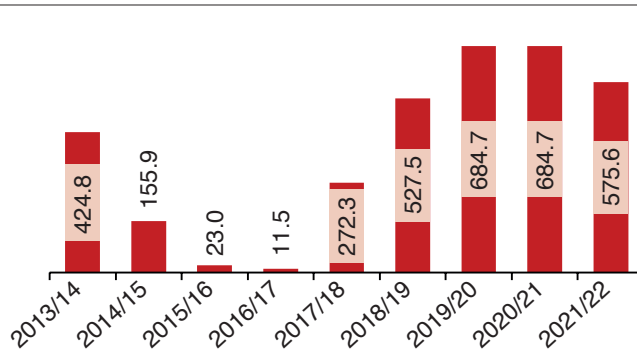
Equitable share (Ksh. million)



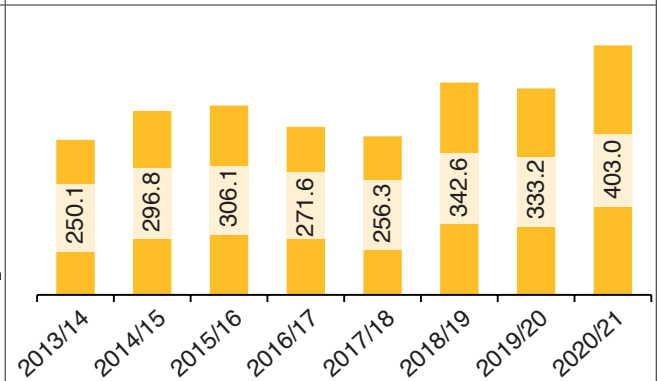
National Government Conditional Grants (Ksh. million)



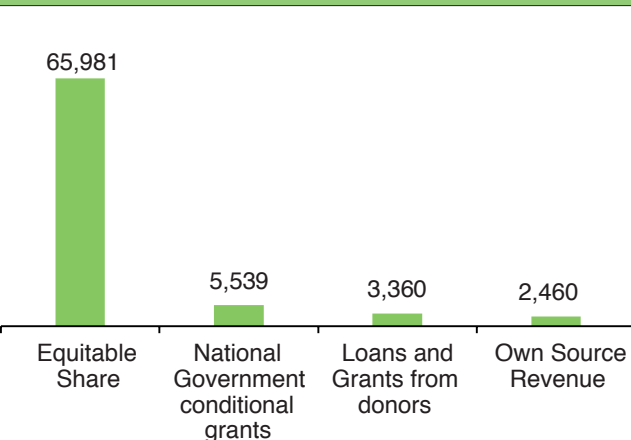
Donor Loans and Grants (Ksh. million)



Own Source Revenue (Ksh. million)

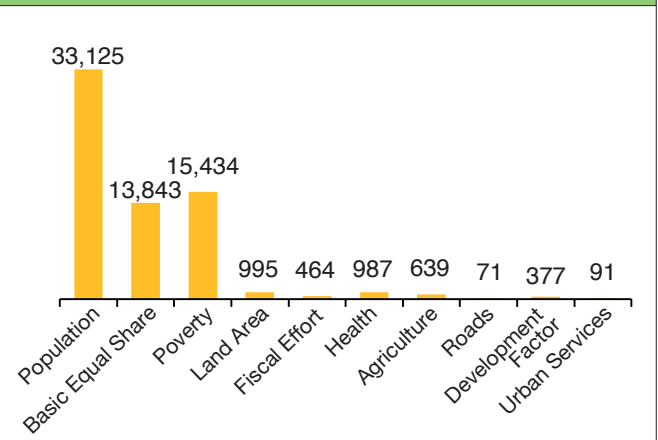


Total County Revenues for FY 2012/13 - 2021/22* (Ksh. million)
